- 1 **LIEBFRAUMILCH 2006/07**
FRANZ REH - Germany
Medium-sweet, nice shape and length. (5) 9.5%vol

PAYS D'OC - France
Fresh, dry, grassy Sauvignon. Its cool bright style has a savoury nettly character that works equally well as an aperitif or with food. (1) 12.5%vol

ARALDICA, VALDADIGE - Italy
Easy drinking and very capably made. Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. (2) 12%vol

CENTRAL VALLEY - Chile
Lively with exotic tropical flavours of banana, melon and pineapple. Notes of lemon backed with vanilla-oak silky texture provide length and shape. (2) 13.5%vol

VICTORIA - Australia
Intense citrus aromas lead into a palate of fine detailed flavours, richness, viscosity and pace. Here is Chenin Blanc as it should be, but rarely is, from the New World. (4) 12%vol

- 6 **ST HALLETT POACHER'S BLEND 2005/06**
BAROSSA - Australia
St Hallett's are famed for their big flavours. Blending Semillon, Sauvignon and Riesling, makes a rich wine - high aromatic notes over the lean grassy edge, backed with a bit of weight. (2) 12%vol

- France
Attractive young Chablis with its cool signature style of wet pebbles. (2) 12.5%vol

- 9 **AVANTI SHIRAZ-MALBEC,**
BODEGAS BORBORE 2007/08,
SAN JUAN - Argentina
Richly coloured and scented it is an easy-drinking blend. With Shiraz taking centre stage to give a smoky, spicy palate supported by a firm Malbec grip. (B) 13.5%vol

- 10 **VILLA ROSA MERLOT 2006/07**
RAPEL - Chile
Ripe, fleshy aroma. Succulent and mouth-filling, softening to a velvety finish. (C) 13.5%vol

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2006/07
CENTRAL VALLEY - Chile
Intense blackcurrant and dried fruit flavours with a hint of mint, toasted almond, tea, tobacco and cedar oak flavours are melded together with a soft backbone and long finish. (C) 14%vol

- 12 **BENCHMARK SHIRAZ, GRANT BURGE 2005/06**
- South Australia
Rich aromas of pepper, dark berries and spice. On the palate there are layers of oak, fruit and savoury spice with a smooth finish as long as a tiger's tail. (D) 14.5%vol

- 13 **MALBEC PEDRO DEL CASTILLO,**
CAVAS WEINERT 2006/07,
MENDOZA - Argentina
Characteristic Malbec with deep colour and leafy, fruity aroma, follows on with a wrap-around mouthful of soft, smooth, evenly-aged fruit. (C) 14%vol

- 14 **ST. HALLETT GAMEKEEPER'S RESERVE 2006/07,**
BAROSSA - Australia
This curious blend of French and Portuguese grapes comes together with a burst of hedgerow and black berry fruit to create a wine of depth and intensity. (D) 14.5%vol

- 15 **CHÂTEAU BOIS NOIR**
BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR 2002 - France
A gently oaked, well-rounded wine with 80% Merlot to give a fleshy, fruity weight and plenty of black Cabernet berry style. Vanilla and nougat notes from the oak provide layers of flavour. (D) 13.5%vol

PENEDES - Spain
