2019 Calendar And Tariff

The Arundell Arms has been England's best-known fly fishing school for over 75 years. Each year we run a number of beginners' fly-fishing courses, and also give individual and group tuition from novice to advanced level. We have 2 full-time instructors, David Pilkington, (AAPGA) and Alexander Jones.

Fly Tying

Tuition in fly tying can be arranged subject to availability of an instructor, at any convenient time. The tuition can then be tailored to suit the pupil, and would cover all the basic techniques of tying-in, bodies, hackles, wings and much more. Sessions would normally be two hours, either morning or afternoon. This is usually sufficient to allow pupils to tie a fly or two, which they could then use on our water.

Materials and hooks, and use of tools, is included.

£110 per person - maximum 3 persons per session.

Four-Day Beginners' Course

A four-day course in trout fishing for beginners from age 11 upwards. Our most popular course. Complete beginners, handling a fly rod for the first time, can come on one of these courses and be led gradually, stage by stage, to the point where after four days they will be able to fish for river and lake trout reasonably well by themselves.

The course involves a day's casting instruction followed by a day's stillwater fishing at Tinhay Lake, leading to two days' fishing on the rivers. This in-depth, practical instruction is combined with workshops and lectures on tackle, safety, fly-tying, entomology, rivercraft, fish behaviour and much more.

This course - while continually updated - has been run at The Arundell Arms for over 60 years and has been the starting point for thousands of fly fishers.

Two-Day Beginners' Course

A condensed version of our four-day course, the weekend two-day course involves a day on the lake followed by a day on our beautiful rivers. Practical instruction in trout fishing is combined with workshops and lectures to give a comprehensive grounding in the sport. You will be taught basic fly casting, fly choice, knots, the habits of fish and the techniques with which to catch them.

Salmon Fishing Beginners' Course

A weekend course, timed towards the latter part of the season when runs of fish should be at their best, for experienced trout fishers aspiring to transfer their skills to the Atlantic salmon. The course covers modern spey casting techniques, rivercraft, fly selection, the salmon's life cycle, and much more.

Three-Day Introduction to River Fishing

This course specifically targets experienced still-water anglers who aspire to progress into the world of river fishing. Over the 3 days you will be shown the casting styles, fishing techniques and rivercraft necessary to gain confidence for fishing on flowing water. If you have a few seasons experience on still-waters, and think there may be a more to this fly fishing game, then this is the course for you.

Fishing Courses Terms And Conditions

Tuition, guiding, courses and fishing day tickets are all available to non-residents of the hotel. The course and tuition prices include all fishing charges and tackle hire, but breakages must be paid for. An Environment Agency fishing licence is not included, and can be obtained from the Post Office or online from the EA. Unless otherwise stated, accommodation at the hotel is not included, for these charges please see hotel tariff.

A 'full day' covers a minimum of four hours with an instructor; plus fishing on the beat for the day. A 'half day' covers a minimum of two hours with an instructor; plus fishing for the remainder of the morning or afternoon session.
Deposit: We request a 50% course fee deposit per participant on booking. This deposit will be returned if you give us more than 31 days notice of cancellation.
